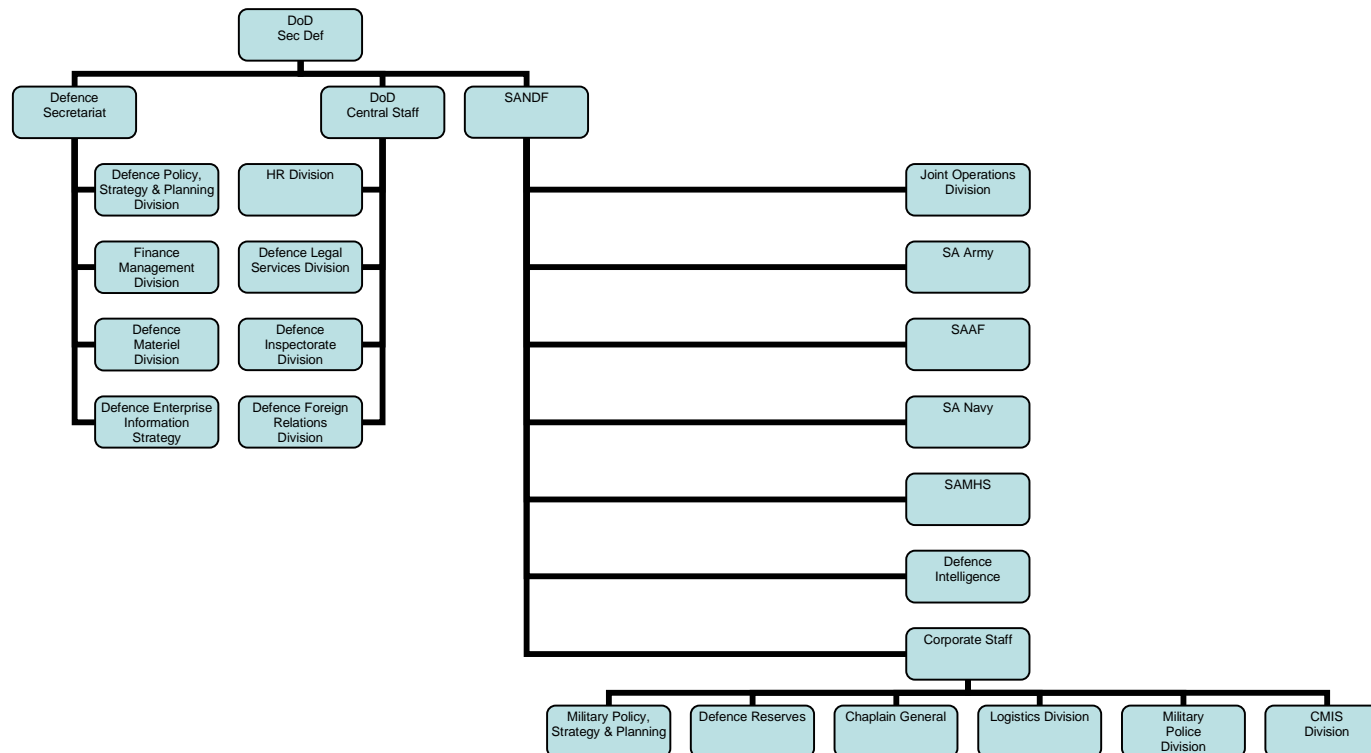


SANDF Structures

Find below a comparison of the DOD/SANDF's structure in 2005, 2006 and 2007. Noteworthy in the latest structure, unveiled with little explanation on March 22, 2007 in a briefing regarding the DoD budget and strategic plan for FY2007/8, is the new "Central Staff" and the change in nomenclature in many a division's name; one example being the Defence Materiel Division (DMD), previously the DAPD or Defence Acquisitions and Procurement Division. At the time it was said that the new structure was the result of the Defence Update, which as far as can be determined must still be approved by Cabinet before it can be tabled in Parliament – or enter the public domain.

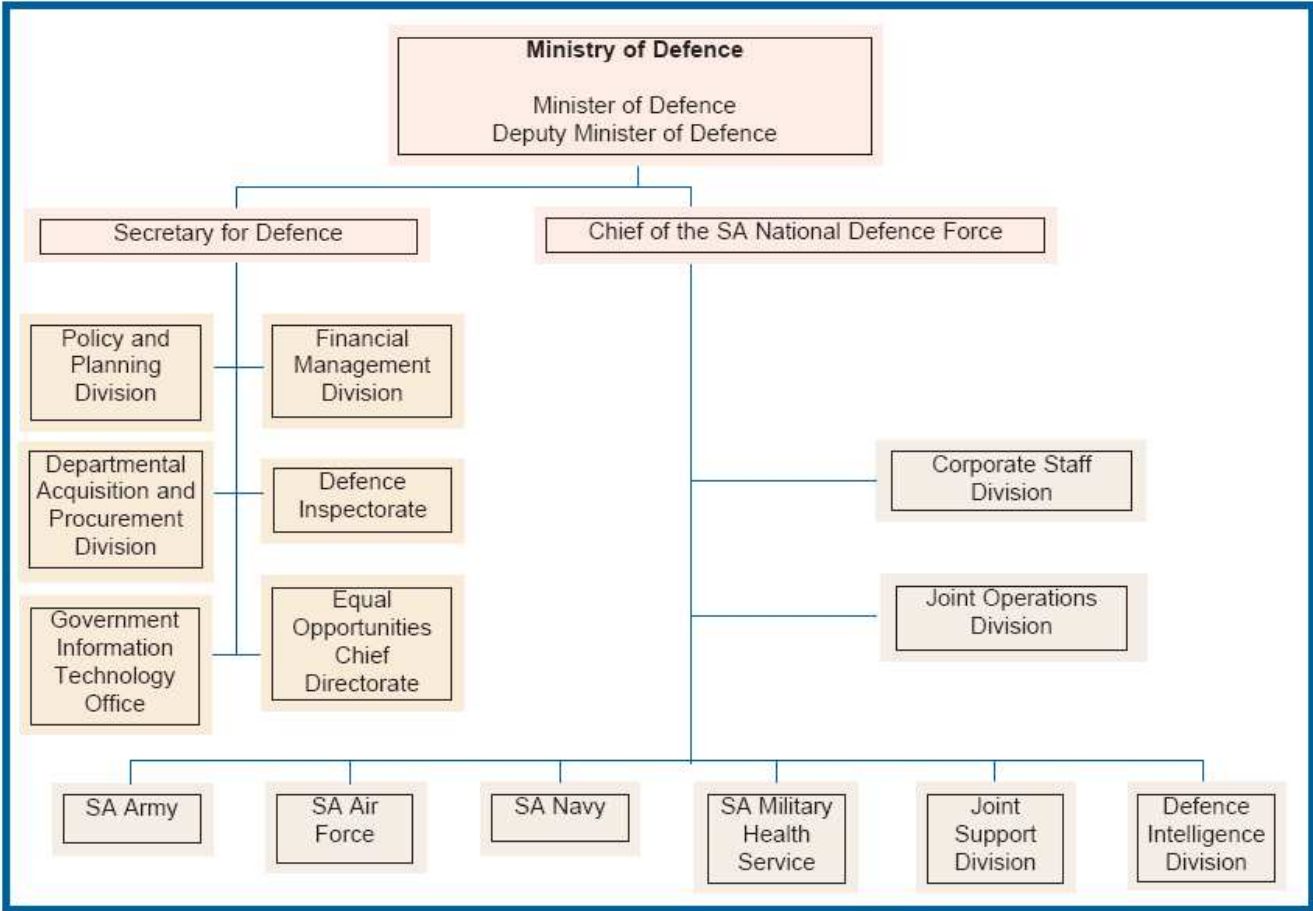


Figure 1: Source: DoD Annual Report 2005
